Hunger Relief	<ul style="list-style-type: none">Food pantries located in Granby, Kremmling, and Walden.Open to anyone in need of groceries. Can visit weekly.Granby: Monday-Thursday 9am-3pm, Friday 9am-12.Kremmling: Tuesday and Thursday 10am-2pm.Walden: 1st, 3rd, 4th, 5th Wednesday from 2pm-4pm.Partner pantry at Changes Thrift in Fraser. Shelf stable items only.Mobile Food Pantry: Wednesdays May-September. Locations vary by week. Visit our website for more information.Totes: Snack totes offered at local schools and libraries.
Rent/Utility Assistance	<ul style="list-style-type: none">Residents of Grand or Jackson County for 6 months or more are eligible for assistance once per year.Assistance can cover 50-75% of rent and up to \$1,000.00 for gas, electric, propane, or firewood.Contact Alex or Silvina at the main office at 970-557-3186.
Town of Granby Water Assistance	<ul style="list-style-type: none">Residents of the Town of Granby in certain districts are eligible for assistance for their facility fee on their water bill.Contact Alex at 970-557-3186 to inquire about eligible addresses.
Vision Vouchers (Sponsored by Fraser River Valley Lions Club)	<ul style="list-style-type: none">Grand County residents. Must demonstrate financial need.Voucher to cover the cost of eye exam and glasses at Winter Park Optical in Fraser. Dental/Hearing/Misc. Medical Assistance	<ul style="list-style-type: none">Grand County residents for at least 6 months. Must demonstrate financial need.Financial assistance to help cover cost of one-time, urgent dental, hearing or certain other medical needs.
